- Community Support Services to remove barriers to employment such as travel training, support with daily planning/self-care, etc.
- Support to succeed in post-secondary education or certification courses

- Reside in Arlington County

- Be dedicated and motivated to gaining support and reaching your employment and/or educational goals
- Age 16 or older
