Here are some things you should know about all the COVID-19 vaccines:

- All COVID-19 vaccines currently available in the United States are very effective against the disease.
- The most common side effects are pain in the arm where you get the shot, tiredness, headache, body aches, chills, and fever.
- Stopping a pandemic requires using all the tools we have available—wearing masks, staying at least 6 feet apart from people who don't live with you, avoiding crowds and poorly ventilated spaces, washing your hands frequently, and **getting vaccinated**.
