COMMUNICATION

High tech and low tech options such as AAC devices, communication boards, tablets, eye gaze, head control, switches, etc.

COMPUTER ACCESS

Word dictation, screen readers, adaptive mice and keyboards, etc.

SENSORY

Weighted vests, pressure vests, weighted lap blankets, tactile input, lighting, etc.

The Assistive Technology Industry Association (ATIA) defines Assistive Technology (AT) "as any item, piece of equipment, software program, or product system that is used to increase, maintain, or improve the functional capabilities of persons with disabilities."

Once your AT is set up and customized, the next step is learning how to use it. ServiceSource will provide you and your support team with training on how to use your AT and how to change settings as your needs and desires change. A combination of in-person and telehealth options may be available for training.

ACCESSING SERVICES

ServiceSource is a Medicaid Waiver provider. You can use your Therapeutic Consultation waiver service to obtain services (FIS & CL Waivers only).

If you do not have a Medicaid waiver, contact us about other funding options.
